A limited number of Graduate Assistantships are available for qualified applicants pursuing graduate degrees in each of the following concentrations:

Graduate Assistantships offer the following:

1. Full tuition waiver for 4 semesters (recipients need to be enrolled as full-time students)
2. Stipends ranging from \$4,000-\$7000 per year

Application Deadlines: February 20, 2017

Students receiving Graduate Assistantships are required to pay applicable Student Health and Student Activities Fees that are not covered by the award package. Recipients must maintain a 3.0 GPA throughout the course of their studies, remain enrolled full time, and satisfactorily perform their assigned duties.
